
Important Note From The Principal's Desk



Dear Parents (Class I to VIII),

Classes for the new academic year will commence on 5th June 2025. We are beginning this academic year with new vigour and enthusiasm. We have also introduced several new initiatives for our students, including a new curriculum for Classes I to V, and a new testing module for Classes I to VIII.

- The new testing system is called the Cycle Test, which is a standardized test conducted at regular intervals for the students in school. This will help train them for Board Examinations in the future. This initiative is in line with the National Education Policy, which may introduce board exams at Class V and Class VIII.
- We will also ensure that the integration with AAKASH (Classes VI to VIII)
 happens in a seamless manner so that both the AAKASH curriculum and
 the NCERT curriculum are well-aligned, and students are exposed to
 multiple Olympiad examinations.
- As you are aware, we have a wide range of activities at our school, including Music, Dance (Bharatanatyam, Western), Vocal (Carnatic, Western), and Instrumentals such as Piano, Keyboard, Guitar, Violin (Carnatic, Western), Drums, Veena, Mridangam, and Tabla. This year, we are expecting a greater number of students to enroll in the Kalai Kaviri & Trinity examinations and discover their passion through our school.
- We also offer many sports activities like Volleyball, Basketball, Cricket, Football, Billiards, Chess, Carrom, Table Tennis, Badminton, and other activities including Karate, Silambam, and Swimming. In addition, school buses will be available at 5:30 PM on all days (Monday to Friday). Only point-drop facility will be available for the students who are staying back for the activity classes.

Important Note From The Principal's Desk



- We will let your children explore the various specializations at our school for the first two weeks and help them understand the different activities they have the privilege of choosing. Evening specialization will commence from 23.06.2025 (Monday). If you are interested in your ward taking up these specialization classes, a form will be sent from the school wherein you will choose the desired activity and mark your enrolment.
- For hostel students, kindly note that the out-pass will not be issued on any
 days other than those mentioned in the academic calendar. Any violation of
 hostel norms may lead to strict disciplinary action, including vacating the
 hostel. Outside food will not be permitted in the hostel. Visitation will be
 permitted only when classes are not scheduled for the students.
- Phone call timings will be strictly adhered to this year to ensure there is no rush during telephone calls. The timings are as follows: IV to VIII - 9:00 PM to 10:00 PM
- All holidays are as per the schedule mentioned in the academic calendar (attached below). Any changes to the academic calendar will be notified via a separate message.
- · Portions missed due to a student's absence from school will not be retaught.

Note:

- Class I to V Parents are required to collect their wards' uniform from the school office on 03.06.2025 (Tuesday).
- All Students are expected to come to school in full uniform, including shoes and socks, from the day of reopening.

We sincerely hope our students take part in all these activities and avoid taking leave, to have a truly wholesome experience at Paavai.
